BY MAIL, OR IN PERSON**
You may also register at
the poll on election day

ONGOING

Check your registration or register to vote at <https://www.myvote.wi.gov/en-us/Register-To-Vote>. The last day to register online is March 15.

How do you register by mail? The last day to register by mail is March 15. Register in person by going to your county clerk's office. The last day to register in person is March 31.
