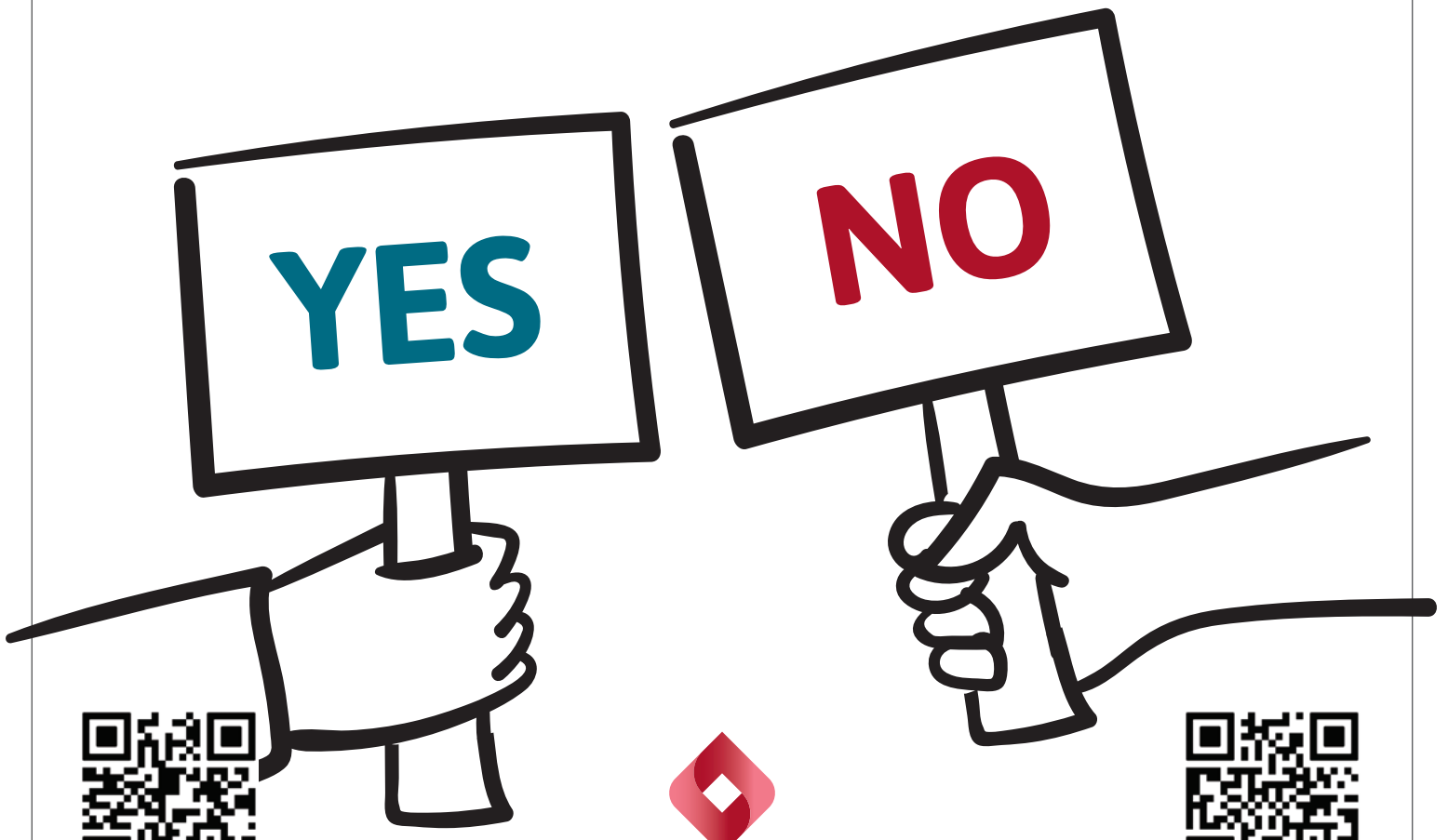
BALLOT MEASURE GUIDE ON KEY INITIATIVES

— WISCONSIN —

Question 1 – Amends the state constitution to erode voting rights protections.

- The Wisconsin constitution guarantees that every U.S. citizen has the right to vote. Question 1 would change this wording to “only U.S. citizens,” allowing lawmakers to restrict voting rights in the future.
- If Question 1 passes, Wisconsin could enact strict proof of citizenship requirements that will prevent many eligible voters from casting a ballot. People of color, low-income communities, and other communities most impacted by HIV are less likely to have the documents needed to prove their citizenship.
- State elections are already secure and use multiple safeguards to ensure that only eligible voters can vote.
