# Wisconsin requires photo ID to vote in person.

## ID must have your name and photo

### **Most people show:**

*Ok if expired after Nov. 8, 2022*

- WI driver's license or ID
- Military ID issued by US
- US passport

### **You can also show:**

- Veterans Affairs Card  
*(Unexpired or no expiration)*
- Tribal ID issued by tribe in WI  
*(Can be expired)*
- Certificate of Naturalization  
*(Issued within 2 years)*
- WI state ID receipt

### **If you're a student, you can show student ID issued by institution accredited in WI:**

- *Must show your signature*
- *Must show date of issuance and expiration date*
- *Must expire within 2 years of issuance date*
- *If your ID is expired, you must also show proof of enrollment (examples: tuition fee receipt, course schedule)*
